17	A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and
18	Transmission Line Siting Committee ("Committee") regarding the Application of UNS
19	Electric, Inc. ("UNSE") for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility to authorize
20	construction of the Black Mountain to Griffith 230 kV Generation Tie Line ("Project").
21	The Project consists of an approximately 3 mile, single-circuit 230 kV transmission line
22	mounted on steel monopole structures. The Project will interconnect the future Black
23	Mountain Generation Station expansion with the Griffith Substation. A map of the Project
