SEQ., NOTICE OF HEARING 5 FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ENVIRONMENTAL COMPATIBILITY 6 AUTHORIZING THE 1886 SOLAR ENERGY STATION INTERCONNECTION 7 PROJECT LOCATED IN COCONINO COUNTY, ARIZONA. 8

A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD before the Arizona Power Plant and Transmission Line Siting Committee (Committee) regarding the Application of 1886 Solar Energy Station LLC (Applicant) for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility to authorize the 1886 Solar Energy Station Interconnection Project (Project). The Project includes an approximately five-mile transmission line and associated interconnection facilities from the 1886 Solar Energy Station to a planned switchyard to be located along the Moenkopi to Cedar Mountain 500 kV transmission line. All Project components are located in Coconino County, Arizona. A general location map of the Project is attached as Exhibit A.

The hearing will be held at the High Country Conference Center's 1899 Ballroom. 307 West Dupont Ave Flagstaff, AZ 86001. The hearing will be held on Thursday, September 7, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. and will continue, as necessary, on Friday, September 8, 2023, beginning at 9:00 a.m. If any revisions to the hearing schedule are required, will noticed the Project website they be on at https://www.swcavirtualpublicinvolvement.com/1886-solar and on the Arizona Corporation Commission (ACC) website at https://www.azcc.gov/arizona-powerplant/meeting-schedule.

not less than ten (10) days before the date set for the hearing, file Notice of Intent to
Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200
West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007.

The Committee or the Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other 7 persons parties to the proceedings. Any person may make a limited appearance at the 8 hearing by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, Arizona 9 Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007, and the 10 Chairman of the Committee at 2005 North Central Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85007, not less 11 than five (5) days before the date set for the hearing. A person making a limited 12 appearance will not be a party or have the right to present testimony or cross-examine 13 witnesses. 14

This proceeding governed by Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.) §§ 40-360 to 40-360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code (AAC) R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No substantive communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of the Committee. The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceedings on the matter before the ACC must be a party to the proceedings before the Committee.
